

3. The 1st and 2nd Defendants deliver up by 2pm Friday 28th February 2003 to the Court Administrator of this Court all or any travel documents they possess in relation to the said wards. This is to include any passports, birth certificates or any other travel documents in the 1st and 2nd Defendants own names in respect of which the wards are mentioned.
4. The 1st and 2nd Defendants deliver up by 2pm Friday 28th February 2003 all or any travel documents, including passports, birth certificates, drivers licences in their own names.
5. The Social Services Department do, as a matter of urgency so that the international obligations of this jurisdiction may speedily be carried out, produce a social inquiry report in respect of the said wards within 10 days of the date hereof.
6. A copy of this order be served on Mr. O. C. Connor, Chief Immigration Officer of the Immigration Department of the Cayman Islands.
7. The principal application is to come for hearing within 14 days of the date hereof, and that the time period for the Defendants to acknowledge service of this application be abridged to 4 days.
8. A penal notice be attached to this order.
9. Such further order or directions as the Court deems fit in the circumstances.
