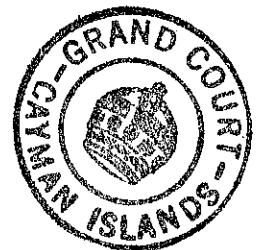
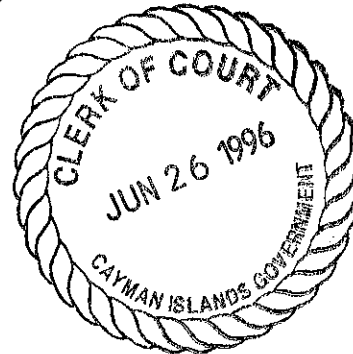
ORIGINATING SUMMONS

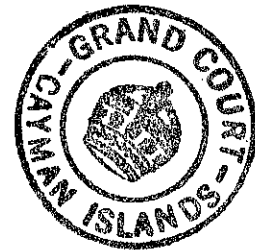
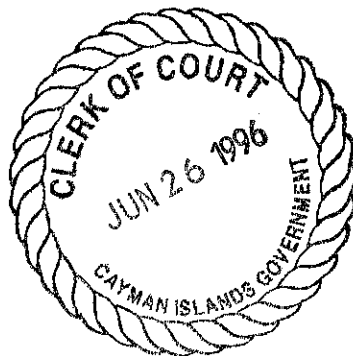
- (1) This Summons may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is*
