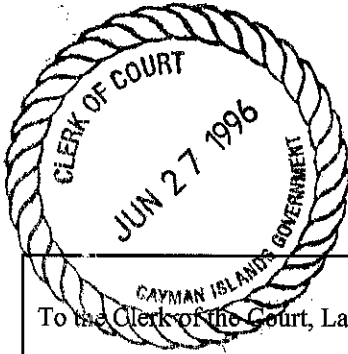

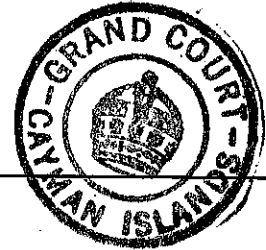

Judgement, order, decision or other proceeding in respect of which relief is sought	The purported decisions of the Immigration Board made on 10th and 24th days of April 1996 in relation to an application by Island Companies Limited under the Local Companies (Control) Law (1995 Revision), such application having been duly granted by the said Board at its meeting on 17th April 1996.

**Relief Sought**

1. An order for certiorari quashing the decision of the Immigration Board made on the 10th day of April 1996 whereby it purportedly declined Island Companies' application.
2. An order of certiorari quashing the order of the Immigration Board made on the 24th day of April 1996 whereby it purportedly revoked its order of 17th April 1996 granting Island Companies' application.
3. A declaration that the order granting Island Companies application on 17th April 1996 was validly, properly and legally made by the Immigration Board and should stand. Alternatively, that the further hearing of Island Companies' fresh application, as proposed by the Immigration Board and fixed for hearing on 29th May 1996, proceed at such date, time, and place as this Honourable Court may direct.
4. An order that if this ex parte application for leave to apply for judicial review is granted that the inter partes application hearing pursuant to the grant of such leave be heard by this Honourable Court on 12th to 16th August 1996 (inclusive).
5. Such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court deems just

## GROUNDS ON WHICH RELIEF IS SOUGHT

1. The facts upon which this application for leave to apply by way of judicial review for an order of certiorari to quash the decisions of the Immigration Board purportedly made on 10th and 24th April 1996 is based are fully set out in the affidavit of Mr F. Renard Moxam sworn and filed herein to which the Applicant, Island Companies Ltd, craves leave to refer.
2. Having regard to the facts as set out in paragraphs 9 to 22 of Mr Moxam's affidavit the legal basis and grounds upon which the order is sought and the relief claimed in the application form filed herein is summarised as follows, that:
  - (i) the order purportedly made on 10th April 1996 by the Immigration Board is void and of no legal effect having been made in breach of the rules of natural justice and because it is tainted by illegality, irrationality and procedural impropriety; and
  - (ii) the order purportedly made on 24th April 1996 by the Immigration Board is void and of no legal effect having been made in breach of the rules of natural justice and because it is tainted by illegality, irrationality and procedural impropriety.
3. Accordingly, Island Companies respectfully request a hearing in Chambers of this application pursuant to Order 53 Rule 3(3) of the Grand Court Rules, 1995.
