

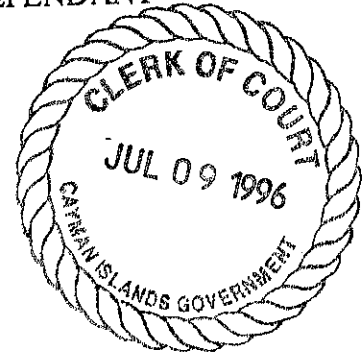

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

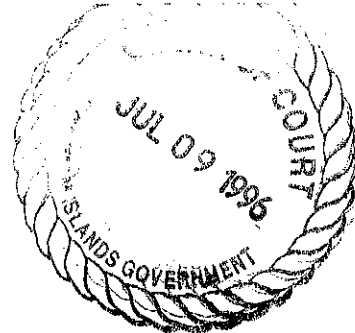

Special Endorsement



1. The plaintiff is a builder and business-man.
2. The defendant operates a business and lives in George Town.
3. On the 25th day of February, 1995 the defendant, in writing, promised to repay the plaintiff the sum of \$2,500.00 which he had borrowed from him on the 27th day of December, 1993.
4. The defendant paid the plaintiff the sum of \$400.00 leaving a balance of \$2,100.00 unpaid, which, by letter dated the 21st July, 1995, through his Attorney, Mr. John Furniss, the plaintiff demanded.
5. However, the defendant went off to Jamaica without paying the plaintiff. After the defendant returned to the island six weeks ago, the plaintiff again demanded his money but the defendant has failed to pay hiim.

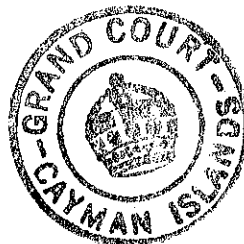
