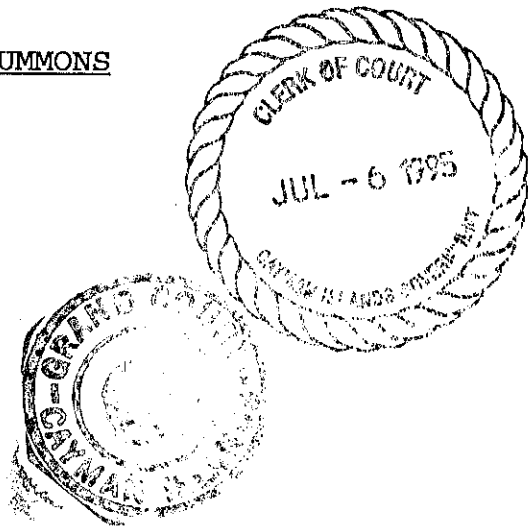

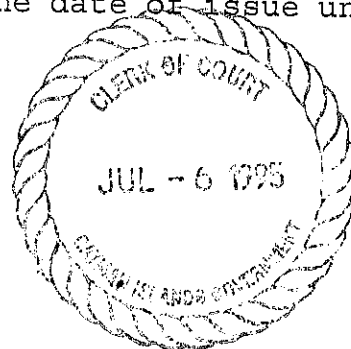
If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

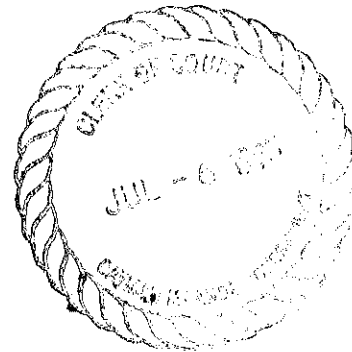

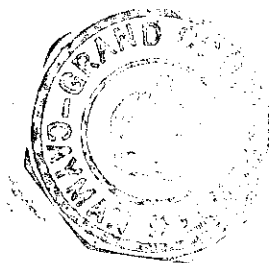
STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff's claim is for CI\$2,302.61 in respect of the outstanding balance on account in respect of goods credited to the Defendant by the Plaintiff.



PARTICULARS

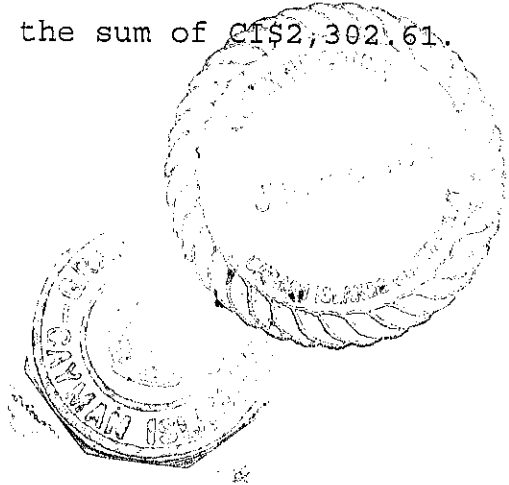
1. The Plaintiff is a wholesaler and retailer of, inter alia, hotel and restaurant supplies. It is incorporated and licensed to carry on business in the Cayman Islands having its place of business at North Sound Road, George Town, Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendant is a resident of the Cayman Islands whose address for service is P.O. Box 194, West Bay, Grand Cayman.
3. Between March 1991 and April 1992 the Plaintiff extended to the Defendant for the purpose of operating his then business the Island House Restaurant and Bar, a line of credit under which the Defendant credited goods to the value of CI\$2,302.61.



4. Despite numerous demands for payment made by the Plaintiff and the Plaintiff's attorney-at-law the Defendant has failed to make any payment towards this outstanding debt.
5. The Defendant owes the Plaintiff the sum of CI\$2,302.61.

**AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-**

1. The sum of CI\$2,302.61;
2. Interest thereon pursuant to Section 62 (1) of the Judicature Law at the rate of 8 3/8 % per annum from the date of judgment until satisfaction.
3. Fixed costs pursuant to Order 62 Rule 1 (c) of the Grand Court Rules, 1995 of CI\$250.00 together with costs of filing this Writ.



If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of CI\$2,302.61 plus interest and costs further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his attorney.
