THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

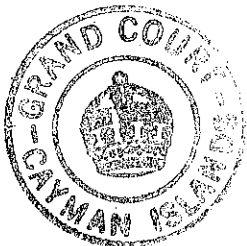
If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

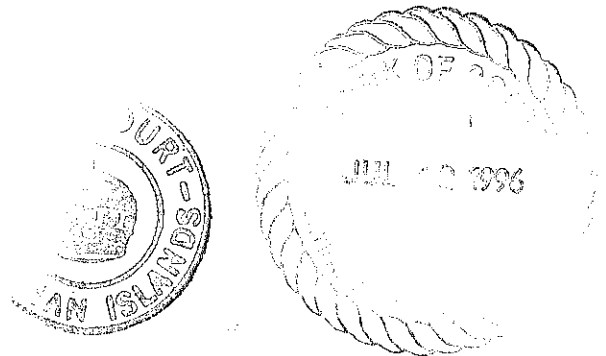
STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. Pursuant to a Promissory Note dated 23rd March 1995 the Defendant agreed to repay to the Plaintiff the sum of CI\$19,200.00 by monthly instalments. The said Promissory Note provided that, in case any instalment was not paid on the due date, the whole balance then unpaid would forthwith become due and payable.
2. The Defendant has failed to maintain payment of the said monthly instalments and by reason of her default has become liable to pay the full amount due and owing under the Promissory Note being the sum of CI\$16,118.20.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:

1. The said sum of CI\$16,118.20.
2. Interest pursuant to Section 34 (1) of The Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at 7 3/8% per annum at a daily rate of CI\$3.25 per day.
3. Costs.
