

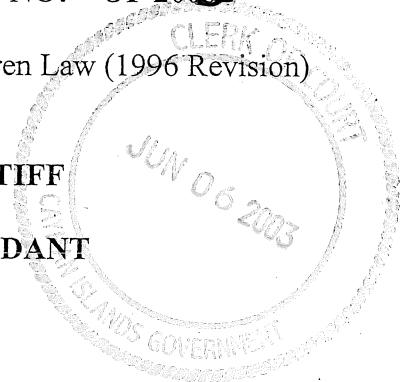

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE
OF DIVORCE PETITION

IF YOU INTEND TO INSTRUCT AN ATTORNEY TO ACT FOR YOU GIVE HIM THIS FORM IMMEDIATELY

1. The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an attorney acting on behalf of the Respondent or by the Respondent if acting in person.
2. After completion it must be signed by the Respondent and his attorney (if any) and must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495 G.T., George Town, Grand Cayman.
3. The Acknowledgment of Service must be filed at court and served on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days service of the Petition.
4. A Respondent who states in his Acknowledgment of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings must also serve an Answer on the attorney for the Petitioner (or on the Petitioner if acting in person) within fourteen days after service of the Petition.
5. The Petition will be treated as an "undefended petition" in respect of which a decree of divorce may be pronounced without the need for any hearing in open court unless an acknowledgment of service form in which you have stated an intention to defend has been filed at the Court Office within fourteen days of service of the Petition.
6. In case of Petitions served outside the Cayman Islands the periods within which the Respondent must file an Acknowledgment of Service and any Answer are extended by fourteen days.
