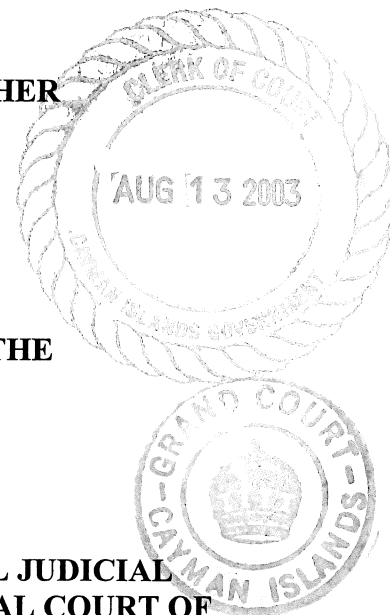


1. Evidence be taken in relation to the above mentioned proceedings in accordance with the above-mentioned Order in Council, pursuant to a request from the Regional Court of Wels.
2. The Registrar of Lands or other custodian of the records of the Land Registry, Grand Cayman, do produce to the Clerk of Court documents in their custody or control relating to the sale and purchase and beneficial ownership of No. 19 Moon Bay, Grand Cayman.

3. The Registrar of Companies or custodian of the records at the Companies Registry do produce to the Clerk of Court documents in their custody or control relating to the incorporation, and current status details of Fidag International Ltd. The documents to be produced are:
 - 3.1 Memorandum and Incorporation of Fidag International Ltd.
 - 3.2 Original Subscribers of Fidag International Ltd
 - 3.3 Register of Shareholders of Fidag International Ltd
 - 3.4 Register of Directors and Officers of Fidag International Ltd
 - 3.5 Any filed returns for Fidag International Ltd

4. The Chief Immigration Officer or custodian of the records at the Immigration Department do produce to the Clerk of Court documents in their custody or control relating to the application for permanent residence in the Cayman Islands by Leopold Steiner and his wife Brigitte.

5. Such further order or directions as this Honourable Court may deem fit.
