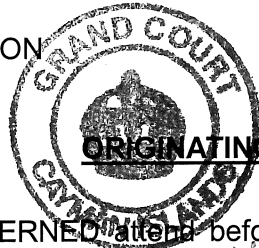

1. That this Honourable Court sanction the variation and/or addition permitting the Plaintiff to rely upon the terms contained in the charge made by the Defendant in favour of the Plaintiff and registered in the Land Registry on ("the Charge") over Registration Section Midland East, Block 59A, Parcel 163 ("the Property") including the power contained in Clause 3(iii) being the power to sell by private treaty.
2. That this Honourable Court sanction the variation and/or addition permitting the Plaintiff to rely upon the terms contained in the Charge over the Property including the power to foreclose or enter into possession of the charged premises contained in Clause 3(ii) of the Charge.
3. That the Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this application from the proceeds of sale of the Property.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 28 days after service of this summons on her counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.
