3. That the cost of this application may be provided for.

The said Minor, Christopher William Peguero was born on August 19, 1993.

The present whereabouts of the Minor is that he is with the Applicants at their home in Lower Valley.

The interest in or relationship to the Minor of the Applicants is that of Grandparents.

The interest in or relationship to the Minor of the Respondent is that of Mother.

If the Respondent does not acknowledge service such judgment may be given or order made against or in relationship to her as the Court may think just and expedient.
