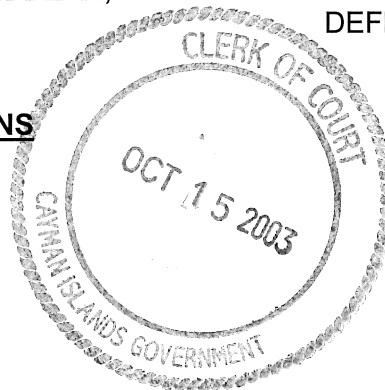

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 28 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months, or if leave is required to effect service outside the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

THE PLAINTIFFS' CLAIM IS FOR

1. Damages for conversion of the property of Cel*Star (Caribbean), Inc and/or unlawful interference in the business of Cel*Star (Caribbean), Inc and/or Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc;
2. A declaration that the purported transfer of shares in or other property in or ownership rights relating to Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc from Wesley Kirton to the Defendant on a date unknown but no earlier than January 2002 was invalid and of no legal effect;
3. Rectification of the register of shareholders of Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc to reflect the declaration sought in 2 above;
4. An Order that the Defendant shall immediately deliver up to Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc and/or procure the delivery up to Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc all books, documents and papers of Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc that are within its possession or control including (without limitation) all share registers and all share certificates or other documents of title or agreements purporting to transfer the same relating to the issued shares in or ownership of Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc;
5. An Order that the Defendant shall repay to Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc any dividends received by it in respect of the shares in Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc purportedly transferred to it on a date unknown but no earlier than January 2002;
6. An injunction until trial to restrain the Defendant by itself, its servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from disposing of or dealing with:
 - (a) any of the issued shares in, or other property in or ownership rights relating to Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc;
 - (b) any and all assets in the hands of the Defendant which represent the traceable proceeds of any of the aforesaid shares, ownership rights, property or assets;
 - (c) any and all documentation relating to the aforesaid property, assets or ownership rights.
7. An injunction until trial to restrain the Defendant by itself, its servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from holding itself out as a shareholder of Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc or purportedly exercising any rights as a shareholder of Cel*Star (Guyana), Inc;

8. Further and/or other relief;
9. Interest; and
10. Costs.
