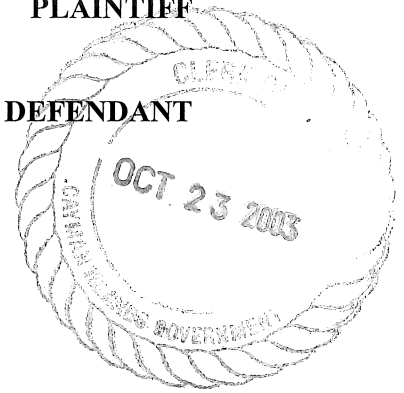

WRIT OF SUMMONS

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ISSUED this 21st day of October 2003.

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at Elgin Avenue, Grand Cayman and the Defendant is a customer of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendant is indebted to the Plaintiff as follows:
 - i) On her current account #011-01501 in the principal sum of CI\$3,419.00. Interest has accrued on the outstanding balance at a rate of 10% per annum, a daily sum of CI\$0.95 from 18th July 2003 to the date of these proceedings, in the sum of CI\$91.20. Interest will continue to accrue from the date of these proceedings until payment of the debt at the daily rate of CI\$0.95.
 - ii) On her Mastercard account in the sum of US\$1,527.93 (CI\$1,252.90).
3. The Plaintiff made a written demand by letter from its attorneys dated 5th September 2003 but the Defendant has failed to repay the sums outstanding or any part of them.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS AGAINST THE DEFENDANT:-

1. Payment of the sum of CI\$4,671.90.
2. Interest on the sum outstanding on the current account as aforesaid of CI\$91.20 and continuing from the date of these proceedings until payment at a rate of 10% per annum, a daily sum of CI\$0.95.
3. Fixed costs in the sum of CI\$250.00 together with the fee payable for issuing this Writ in the sum of CI\$150.00
4. Further or other relief.
