
**OBJECTIONS TO BILL OF COSTS**

**EXCESSIVE PHOTOCOPYING AND PRINTING CHARGES**

There is no allowance for duplicated or error in printing charges and the rate is far more than is allowed under Order 60 r.17 6.3 (b), there is no reason why 20¢ per page is not a reasonable sum claimed. A photocopy in George Town can be obtained for 10¢ per page, therefore even with a 100% up lift the sum of 20¢ per page for photocopying is reasonable Order 62 r.17 6.3 (a).

**IN CONCLUSION**
