WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: "B", "C" and "D", being the persons identified as the First, Second and Third Defendants respectively in the Order of the Court made herein on 4 November 2003, whose addresses are at his/her respective places of residence in Grand Cayman.

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 5th day of November 2003

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

THE PLAINTIFF'S claim is for:

1. Delivery up of the Plaintiff's documents and copies print-outs or notes of those documents.
2. An injunction to restrain use or disclosure of information deriving from the Plaintiff's documents and such further or other injunctions as are appropriate to protect the Plaintiff's confidentiality.
3. An inquiry into damages and/or an account of profits in respect of misuse of confidential information and/or conversion of the Plaintiff's property and/or breach of copyright and/or breach of contract by the Second and/or Third Defendants and/or the First Defendant inducing or participating in such breach of contract and/or conspiracy.
4. Further or other relief.
5. Costs.
