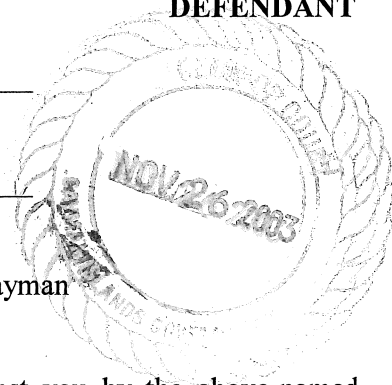

WRIT OF SUMMONS



TO: Glaney Rose Tatum, PO Box 2613GT, Grand Cayman

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ISSUED this 25th day of November 2003.

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a Bank carrying on business at its branch at Elgin Avenue, Grand Cayman and the Defendant is a customer of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendant is indebted to the Plaintiff on her Loan Account #014-04032 in the principal sum of CI\$20,252.98.
3. Pursuant to the loan agreement entered into between the Plaintiff and the Defendant on 22nd December 1998, the principal and interest accrued is repayable upon demand by the Plaintiff. The agreed rate of interest is 8% per annum.
4. The account became delinquent on 31st August 2001 and interest has accrued from the date of the delinquency to the date of these proceedings in the sum of CI\$5,537.31. Interest will continue to accrue from the date of these proceedings until payment of the debt at the rate of 8% per annum, a daily sum of CI\$4.50.
5. The Plaintiff made a written demand for the outstanding debt by letter from its attorneys dated 30th October 2003 but the Defendant has failed to repay the sum outstanding or any part of it.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-

1. Payment of the said sum of CI\$20,252.98.
2. Interest on the principal sum of CI\$5,537.31 and continuing from the date of these proceedings until payment at a rate of 8% per annum, a daily sum of CI\$4.50.
3. Fixed costs in the sum of CI\$500.00 together with the fee payable for issuing this Writ in the sum of CI\$252.53
4. Further or other relief.
