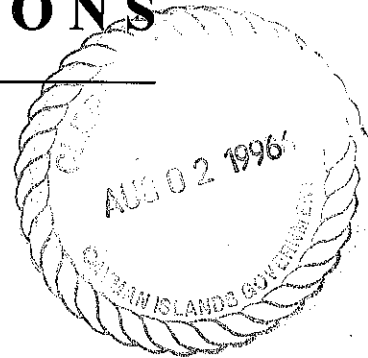
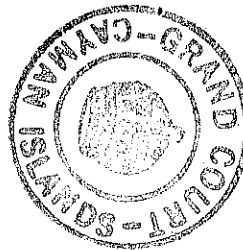

Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 6 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

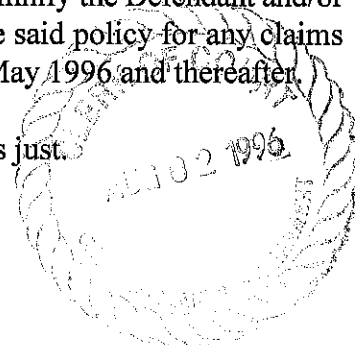
INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff claim against the Defendant is for:

1. A declaration that a certain Medical Malpractice Liability Insurance Policy no. MPL 70526 issued by the Plaintiff to the Defendant and having been in effect from 1st January 1991, is cancelled and /or rescinded as from midnight 31st May 1996 and the Plaintiff is entitled to avoid the said Policy and any claims arising as from midnight 31st May 1996 and thereafter, upon the grounds that the Defendant has failed to pay the consideration due from him to the Plaintiff in the form of premium on or before the due date, and/or upon his failure to otherwise renew and continue the said policy.

FURTHER or alternatively:

2. A declaration that the Plaintiff is not liable to defend and/or indemnify the Defendant and/or is otherwise discharged from its duties and obligations under the said policy for any claims made by anyone against the Defendant as from 12:01am 31st May 1996 and thereafter.
3. Such further and or other relief as this Honourable Court deems just.
4. Costs.

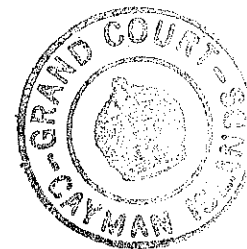
