General for the following orders: -

1. That leave be granted for the enforcement of the Convention award for the recovery of USD \$ 303,464.82 from Tripetrol Oil Trading Inc., S.A, dated March 10, 1999 which is exhibited as "CMR.3" to the affidavit of Cheryll M. Richards sworn herein on the 15th day of December 2003.
2. That the Order made herein and a copy of the affidavit of Cheryll M. Richards dated 15th December 2003 be served upon the debtor, Tripetrol Oil Trading Inc., S.A at its registered office.

3. That within fourteen days after service of the Order herein the said debtor may apply to set aside the Order and the Award shall not be enforced until after expiration of that period or if the debtor applies within the fourteen day period to set aside the Order, until after the application is finally disposed of.

4. Such other Orders and Directions as this Honourable Court may deem fit.
