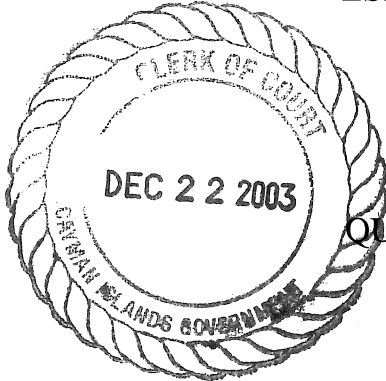

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: QUARRY PRODUCTS LIMITED, PO Box 680 GT, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, BWI

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 22nd day of December 2003

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months [or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

The Plaintiff's claim is for:

1. The sum of CI\$17,471.48, being the sum due pursuant to a written contract for the provision of fuel and oil supplies by the Plaintiff to the Defendant, alternatively as an action on a dishonoured cheque dated 28 November 2003 for CI\$17,451.48 and charges of CI\$20 for the return of the said cheque;
2. Interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) at the prescribed rates from 1 October 2003, being:
 - (1) To the date hereof the sum of CI\$119.04;
 - (2) From the date hereof the daily rate of CI\$1.43, or such other rate as may be prescribed
3. Alternatively, interest for such period and at such rate as to the Court may seem just; and
4. Costs.
