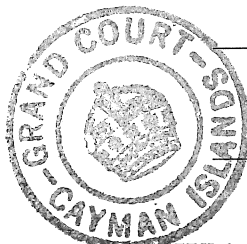

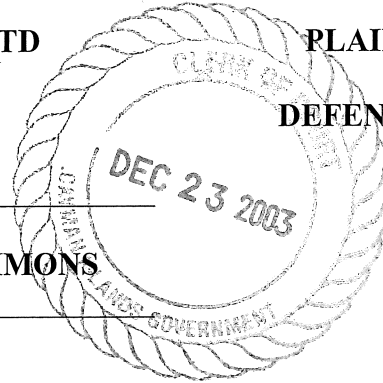

TO: Ellen Whittaker whose address for service is 16A Tempest Way, Windsor Park, George Town, Grand Cayman.


LET THE DEFENDANT, Ellen Whittaker, within 14 days after service of this Summons on her, counting the day of service, return the accompanying acknowledgement of service to the Court office, P. O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

BY THIS SUMMONS which is issued on application of the Plaintiff, Cayman National Bank Ltd., Elgin Avenue, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, British West Indies, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant relief pursuant to the Registered Land Law (1995 Revision) that:-

1. The variations in the Plaintiff's charge to the provisions of the Registered Land Law (1995 Revision) be allowed.
2. The Plaintiff be entitled to sell the Defendant's property by either private treaty or public auction in good faith and having regard to the interests of the Defendant.
3. For the purposes of a sale, the Plaintiff be entitled to vacant possession of the property.
4. This Honourable Court do give directions as to the sale price of the property.
5. Any further relief this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

The grounds upon which the Plaintiff seeks the relief as set out above are contained in the Affidavit of Dale Allen of the Plaintiff.
