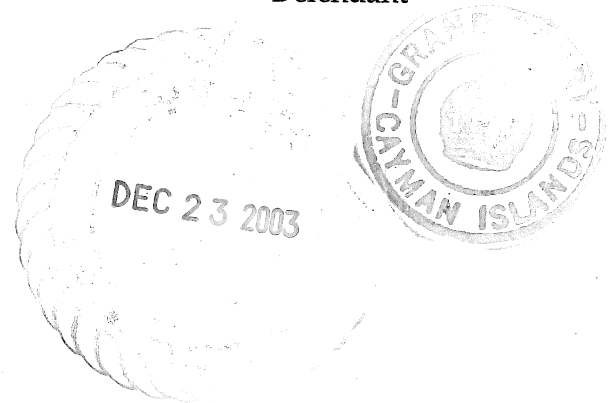

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff, RACHEL KING in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. On 13th December, 2003 the Defendant assaulted the Plaintiff at her student residence in Tampa, Florida.
2. The Defendant was arrested by the Tampa Police, charged with the offence of battery and bailed to attend court in Tampa in January, 2004.
3. The Plaintiff and the Defendant are both Caymanians who have returned to Cayman for the Christmas period.
4. Since the assault pleaded in paragraph 1 the Defendant has been contacting and harassing the Plaintiff.
5. In the circumstances the Plaintiff believes that the Defendant, unless restrained by this Honourable Court, will repeat the tortious act complained of in paragraph 1.

The Plaintiff therefore claims against the Defendant:

- (1) A quia timet injunction restraining the Defendant by himself, his servants, agents or otherwise, from assaulting, molesting, interfering with, approaching or in any way communicating with the Plaintiff (save through his attorneys-at-law) until 1st January, 2004 or further order ;
- (2) An order restraining the defendant from coming within 100 yards of the Plaintiff's home at Butterfly Circle, Newlands, Grand Cayman between the date of this Order and 1st January, 2004.
