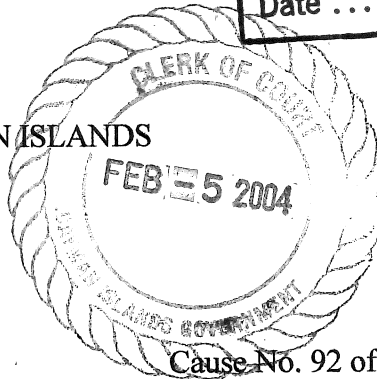

AND I annex hereto my Affidavit in support of my application and the Certificate of Death of the late Lula Mae Winton.




**AND I DECLARE** myself bound unto the Financial Secretary of the Cayman Islands in the amount of CI\$350,000.00.
