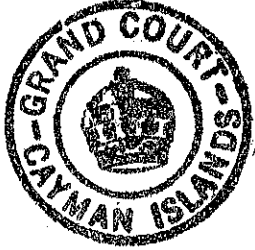

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 22 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court office, P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

### **IMPORTANT**

Directions for Acknowledgement of Service are given with the accompanying form.

The Plaintiffs' claim is for:

- (1) Damages for libel contained in an article dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2004 and headed 'Ritz-Carlton (Cayman) contractor sues developer' which was published by the Defendant on its website, KYC News, on or about 5<sup>th</sup> February 2004 to diverse persons in the Cayman Islands, including a television station, Cayman 27, and a radio station, Radio Cayman.
- (2) Damages for libel caused by the Defendant causing to be republished the libel in broadcasts in the Cayman Islands by Cayman 27 on 6 February 2004 and by Radio Cayman on 9 and 10 February 2004, in which the said article was repeated; and
- (3) An injunction restraining the Defendant, whether by itself, its servants, its agents or otherwise howsoever from further publishing or causing to be published the said or similar libels on the Plaintiffs.
