If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. On or about June, 1995 the Plaintiff and his wife, Theoni Delageorge Aron, agreed to purchase and the defendant agreed to sell land and a block of apartments known as Coral Gardens Apartments, situate at Bodden Town Block 44B, parcel 10 H 1 to 7 for a price of US\$100,000.
2. The Plaintiff and his wife paid US\$100,000 for the apartments and the land.

The Plaintiff therefore claims against the Defendants:

- (1) Rectification of the Land Register to indicate that Alan Leslie Aron and Theoni Delageorge Aron are the registered owners of the land;
- (2) Costs to be taxed, if not agreed.

If within the time for returning Acknowledgement of Service the Defendants execute the necessary documentation for the rectification of the Land Register all further proceedings will be stayed.
