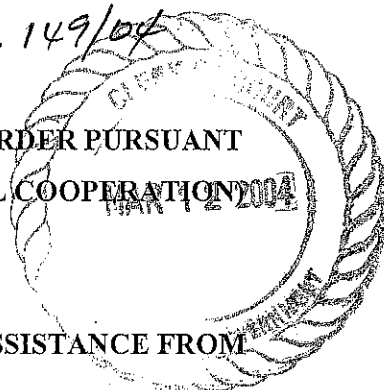

An application having been made in pursuance of Section 11 of The Criminal Justice (International Cooperation) Law (2000 Revision)

By: Detective Chief Inspector Raymond Christian of The Royal Cayman Islands Police Service on behalf of the Norwegian Authorities.

I am satisfied, having heard the application, that the requirements for making a production order under Section 11 of the Criminal Justice (International Cooperation) Law (2000 Revision) are fulfilled.

You are ordered to produce to Detective Chief Inspector Raymond Christian access to material to take away, specifically certified copies of all files, documents, signature cards, bank deposit records, account mandates, accounts and other records used in the ordinary course of business, whether those records are in written form, are kept on microfilm, magnetic tape or any other form of mechanical or electronic data retrieval mechanism, paid cheques, inter account transfers, bank statements and vouchers relating to bank account transactions above the value of USD 1,000.00 in the period between 01st January 2001 and today's date, and correspondence concerning any transactions in relation to the following accounts:

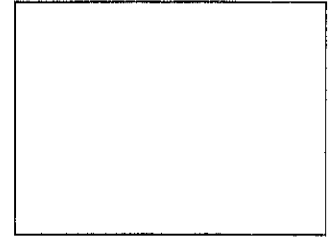
1. 0032540-010-92 (DEM)
2. 00803174/001/96 (EUR)
3. 00803174/002/93 (USD)
4. 00803174/003/90 (NOK)

If the accounts are registered in the names of companies, you are to produce the names of the owners/beneficiaries of the companies, and information on any assets/properties registered in the names of those companies.

I am satisfied after hearing the application that the conditions specified in sub section 4 of Section 11 are fulfilled in relation thereto. You are hereby ordered to:

Produce the said material to Detective Chief Inspector Raymond Christian for him to take away (see notes a &b)

not later than the end of the period of 7 days from the date of the service of this order

- (a) Where the material consists of information contained in a computer, the material shall be produced in a form which it can be taken away and in which it is visible and legible: Section 11(7)(a) of the Criminal Justice (International Cooperation) Law (2000 Revision)
- (b) Where the material consists of information contained in a computer the constable shall be given access to it in a form which it is visible and legible: Section 11(7)(b) of the Criminal Justice (International Co-operation) Law (2000 Revision).
