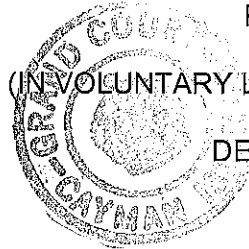
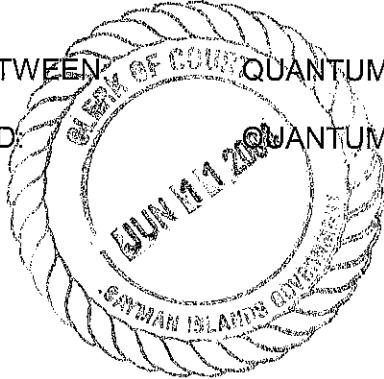


ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT of Caledonian Bank and Trust Limited, Caledonian House, Mary Street, P.O. Box 1043, George Town, Grand Cayman attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 24th day of June 2004 at 9.30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of of Kaya Flamboyan 9, Willemstad, Curaçao, Netherlands Antilles for an Order that:

1. The voluntary winding up and dissolution of Quantum Industrial Partners LDC (the "Company") which occurred by virtue of the operation of section 200(1)(c) of the Companies Law (2003 Revision) (the "Law") be stayed pursuant to section 103 and 141 of the Law until further order of the Court.
2. All dispositions of the property, effects and things in action of the Company and every transfer of shares, or alternation in the status of the members of the Company made since the commencement of the winding up, are valid.
3. The Liquidators(s) of the Company do vacate office forthwith.
4. There be further or other relief.
5. There be no order as to costs.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.
