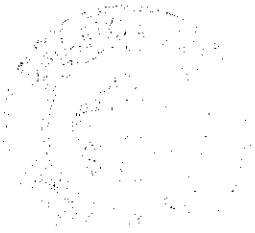

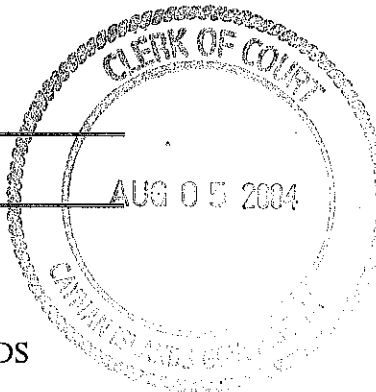

PETITION



TO THE GRAND COURT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

The Humble Petition of Arvella Bodden acting as sole guardian and receiver of Donald Bodden, East End, Grand Cayman shows that:


1. Quarry Products Limited (the "Company") is a company incorporated under the Companies Law (2004 Revision), and was placed in voluntary liquidation on 2nd July 2004
2. The name of the voluntary liquidator (the "Liquidator") is RSM Cayman Islands, 34B Dr. Roy's drive, 4th Floor, British American Building, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. The registered office of the Company is situated at c/o A. Steve McField & Associates, P.O. Box 680, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
4. The Petitioner commenced an action against the company on 10 September 2003 in Cause No. 588 of 2003, seeking special damages and general damages as a result of alleged negligence by the Company resulting in injury and disablement to an employee, Mr. Donald Bodden. Special and General damages are expected to exceed CI\$1,500,000.
5. The Company has denied liability in pleadings prior to its commencing voluntary liquidation, and it is likely that the Liquidator will continue to dispute the action. The

Petitioner intends to seek leave of the Court to continue the action on the grounds that it has a good and bona fide claim.

YOUR PETITIONER THEREFORE HUMBLY PRAYS as follows:

1. That the voluntary liquidation of Quarry Products Limited continue subject to the supervision of the Court in accordance with the provisions of the Companies Law (2004 Revision).
2. That the Liquidator files with the Clerk of the Court a report in writing of the position of and the progress made with the winding up of the Company and with the realisation of the assets thereof and as to any other matters connected to the winding up of the Company, every six calendar months or as the Court may from time to time direct.
3. Since the Petitioner is likely to be the largest contingent creditor of the Company, but with adverse interests to those of the Company and other creditors, the Petitioner requires the conduct of the Liquidator to be supervised by the Court.
4. That the proceedings in Cause 588 of 2003 not be stayed and application for further conduct of Cause 588 of 2003 be heard accordingly.
5. That the costs of the Petitioner and of the Petition be costs in the Cause of 588 of 2003.
6. Such further and/or other relief as the Honourable Court deems appropriate.

NOTE: This petition is intended to be served on the Liquidators of the Company and the Registrar of Companies.
