

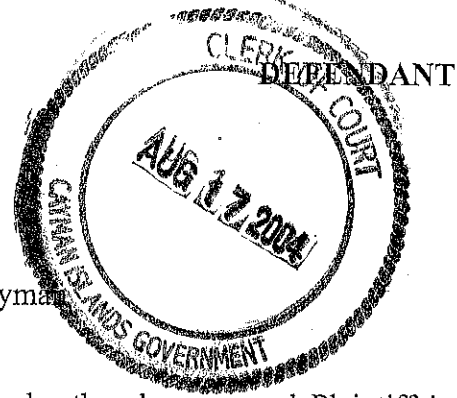

WRIT OF SUMMONS

TO: The Defendant, of P.O. Box 75 WB, Grand Cayman

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 28 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a hotel carrying on business at Seven Mile Beach, Grand Cayman and the First Defendant is, and at all material times has been, a customer of the Plaintiff.
2. The Defendant is indebted to the Plaintiff as follows:
 - i) The Defendant has been a member of the golf club known as the "Britannia Golf Club" which is owned by the Plaintiff. The Defendant joined the club on or about 10th October 2003. As a member of the golf club the Defendant has been able to purchase goods and services from the Plaintiff on credit, on the understanding that any amounts outstanding owing to the Plaintiff are repayable on demand.
 - ii) In between 4th May 2004 and 4th August 2004 the Defendant acquired goods and services on credit to the value of US\$7,851.15. These goods and services included lunches, golf membership and purchases from the professional shop.
3. Following repeated requests for payment by the Plaintiff, the Defendant finally drew a cheque for US\$ 7,125 dated 4th August 2004 upon RBC Centura Bank, Florida payable to the Plaintiff for part payment of the debt.
4. The Plaintiff duly presented the cheque for payment but it was dishonoured. The Plaintiff then called the Plaintiff immediately and advised him that the cheque had been dishonoured.
5. The Plaintiff claims interest pursuant to Section 57 (c) of the Bills of Exchange Law (1997 Revision) at the rate of 8% per annum.

AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:-


1. Payment of the sum of US\$7,851.15 (representing the amount of the dishonoured cheque of US\$7,125 and US\$636.16 representing the outstanding amount) together with interest on this sum at a rate of 8% per annum, amounting to US\$1.72 per day from the date of

default (4th August 2004) until the date of issue of these proceedings, amounting to a sum of US\$ 22.37 and continuing from the date hereof at the daily rate of US\$ 1.72.

2. Fixed costs of CI\$150.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.
3. An order that the Defendant be restrained from leaving the jurisdiction until he provides security for the above amount outstanding.
4. Further or other relief.

If, within the time limited for acknowledging service of these proceedings, the Defendants pay, to the Plaintiff's Attorneys, the total amount claimed (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed.
