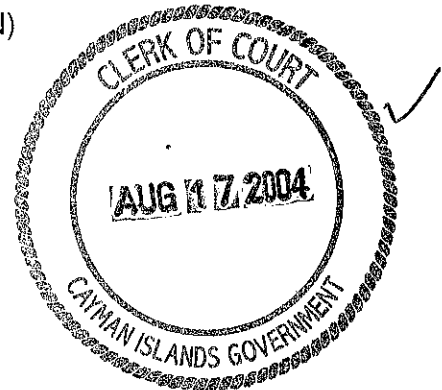

PETITION



TO THE GRAND COURT OF THE CAYMAN ISLANDS

The Humble Petition of Citrico International Ltd of Ugland House, P.O. Box 309 G.T., South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands ("the Company") shows that:

1. Citrico International Ltd ("the Company") is an exempted limited liability company organised and incorporated under the Companies Law of the Cayman Islands.
2. The Registered Office of the Company is situated at Maples and Calder, Ugland House, P.O. Box 309 G.T., South Church Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.
3. The share capital of the Company is US\$50,000 divided into 50,000 shares with a par value of US\$1.00 each of which 100 shares have been issued. The objects for which the Company was established are unrestricted.
4. On 16 August 2004 the following written Resolutions were passed by the sole shareholder of the Company, as Special Resolutions namely:

"IT IS RESOLVED AS SPECIAL RESOLUTIONS THAT:

1. *The Company present a Petition seeking its winding up pursuant to Part V of the Companies Law (2004 Revision); and*
2. *Mr David R Bucey of One Coca-Cola Plaza, Atlanta, Georgia, USA, be authorised and instructed on behalf of the Company to take all necessary steps to present the Petition, seek the Company's winding up and, in the interim, apply on behalf of the*

Company for the appointment of Kenneth Kryss and Christopher Stride of RSM Cayman Islands as Joint Provisional Liquidators of the Company ("the JPLs") For the avoidance of any doubt, this authority shall include authority to retain and instruct legal counsel to act on behalf of the Company."

5. The Company is insolvent and unable to pay its debts.

YOUR PETITIONER THEREFORE HUMBLY PRAYS THAT:

- (1) The Company be wound up by the Court under the provisions of the Companies Law (2004 Revision).
- (2) Such other Order may be made as the Court thinks fit.

AND your Petitioner will ever pray etc.
