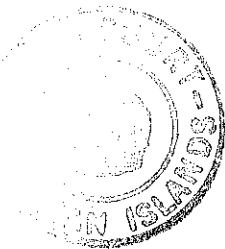
If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

**Special Endorsement**


1. The plaintiff is a local Company with a licence to rent motor cars.

4. The defendant agreed to pay for its repairs and loss of use but despite several demands made on her and promises by her to pay, she has failed to pay

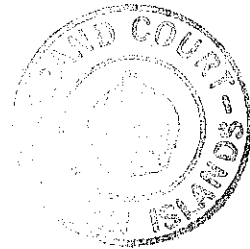
