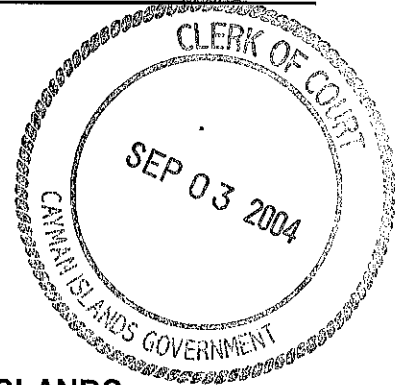

1. Decision dated 25th June 2004 of the Respondent varying the extension granted to the Applicant and his family of 26th May 2004 pursuant to Section 66(2) of the Immigration Law 2003, (Law 34 of 2003).
2. Decision dated 18th June 2004 of the Respondent abrogating the Applicant's right to exercise an appeal against the decision of the Respondent dated 20th February 2004 refusing the Applicant's

- application for Permanent Residency Status pursuant to Section 27(1) of the Immigration Law, 2003 (Law 34 of 2003);
3. Decision dated 28th November 2003 of the Respondent in Council rejecting the Applicant's appeal pursuant to section 53(1) of the Police Law (1995 Revision)

Relief Sought:

1. In respect of decision 1 above certiorari and mandamus directing the Respondent to permit the Applicant to remain on the Island until at least 4th November 2004 or until his appeal rights have been determined in relation to decisions 2 and 3 above;
2. In respect of decision 2 above, certiorari and mandamus directing the Respondent to hear the Applicant's appeal against the Respondent's refusal to grant Permanent Residency Status;
3. In respect of decision 3 above, certiorari and mandamus directing the Respondent-in-Council to conduct an appeal against the Applicant's dismissal in conformity with the principles of natural justice, legitimate expectation and proportionality.
