1. An Order that the full medical reports of Doctors Bernadette Murphy, Lockhart, Von Kirchenheim, and Surat relating to Mario Wilson and currently in the Second Respondent's possession, custody or power be disclosed to the Applicant's attorneys herein;
2. An adjournment of this Application for an Order of Guardianship over the First Respondent allowing sufficient time to obtain the disclosure sought in Paragraph 1 above with liberty to restore the matter to the Court list once disclosure is obtained;
3. Upon the disclosure sought in Paragraph 1 above being obtained or the expert reports pertaining to Mario Wilson being otherwise obtained and presented to the

- Court, an Order that the Applicant be appointed as guardian of the First Respondent;
4. An Order that the Applicant be appointed as receiver for the First Respondent;
 5. An Order that, as guardian of and receiver for the First Respondent, the Applicant shall perform the following duties:
 - (a) manage, sell, acquire, charge or deal with the First Respondent's property and apply all proceeds towards the First Respondent's maintenance and care;
 - (b) enter into any settlement on behalf of the First Respondent;
 - (c) complete contracts on behalf of the First Respondent;
 - (d) conduct legal proceedings on behalf of the First Respondent; and
 - (e) act as trustee for the First Respondent.
 6. A Direction under Order 80, Rule 23(3) that as receiver for the First Respondent, the Applicant need not deliver to the Court annual accounts under Order 80, Rule 23(1); and
 7. An Order that the Applicant, as guardian and receiver for the First Respondent, be authorized to act as his Next Friend and conduct such proceedings as she may be
