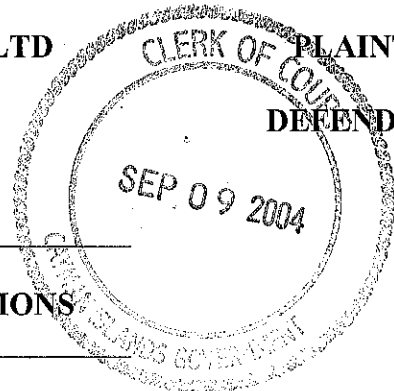

**BY THIS SUMMONS** which is issued on application of the Plaintiff, Cayman National Bank Limited the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant relief pursuant to the Registered Land Law (1995 Revision) as follows:-

1. That the variations in the Plaintiff's charge to the provisions of the Registered Land Law (1995 Revision) be allowed.
2. That the Plaintiff be entitled to sell the Defendant's property by either private treaty or public auction in good faith and having regard to the interests of the Defendant with directions from the Court as to the sale price of the property.
3. That for the purposes of the sale, the Plaintiff be entitled to vacant possession of the property.
4. Any further relief this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

The grounds upon which the Plaintiff seeks the relief as set out above are contained in the Affidavit of Dale Allen of the Plaintiff.
