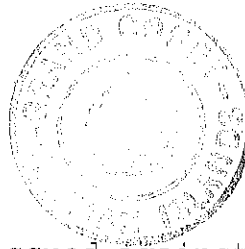

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

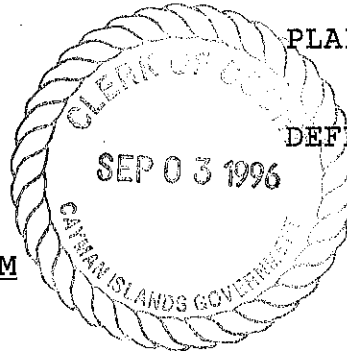


STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. Between February and March, 1995, the Plaintiff was engaged by the Defendant to do certain electrical work eight apartments at West Bay, Grand Cayman.
2. The Plaintiff's cost to the Defendant for completing the said electrical work was CI\$21,658.00 of which the Plaintiff received the sum of CI\$12,755.00 leaving a balance of CI\$8,903.8 owed to the Plaintiff by the Defendant.
3. Further, the Plaintiff advanced the sum of CI\$2600.00 to the Defendant for the Defendant to change the equivalent amount in United States Dollars for the Plaintiff.
4. So far, the Plaintiff has only received the sum of US\$550.00 and the sum of CI\$300.00 from that transaction.
5. By reason of the matters aforesaid, the Defendant remains indebted to the Plaintiff for the balance of CI\$8,903.86 for the electrical work and the sum of CI\$1,851.67 outstanding of the CI\$2600.00.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. The sums of CI\$8,903.86 and the sum of CI\$1,851.67 respectively.
2. Cost and Attorneys Fees.
3. Further or other relief.

[If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of [\$10,755.53] (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.]

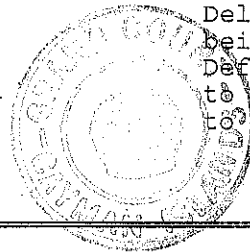
