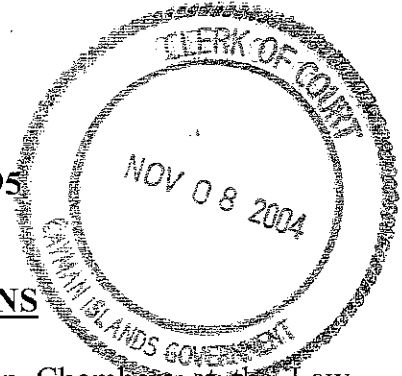

**EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November 2004, at 9:30 a.m., on the hearing of an application by the putative guardian and receiver, Ms Hyacinth Murdock for:

1. An Order that she be appointed as guardian of Daminon Parkins;
2. An Order that she be appointed as receiver for Daminon Parkins;
3. An Order that, as guardian of and receiver for Daminon Parkins, Hyacinth Murdock shall perform the following duties:
  - (a) manage, sell, acquire, charge or deal with Daminon Parkins' property and apply all proceeds towards Daminon Parkins' maintenance and care;
  - (b) enter into any settlement on behalf of Daminon Parkins;
  - (c) complete contracts on behalf of Daminon Parkins;
  - (d) conduct legal proceedings on behalf of Daminon Parkins; and
  - (e) act as trustee for Daminon Parkins.
4. A Direction under Order 80, Rule 23(3) that as receiver for Daminon Parkins, Hyacinth Murdock need not deliver to the Court annual accounts under Order 80, Rule 23(1); and

Daminon Parkins

5. An Order that Hyacinth Murdock, as guardian and receiver for Daminon Parkins, be authorized to act as Daminon Parkins' Next Friend and conduct such proceedings as she may be advised in the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands on behalf of Daminon Parkins in respect of Daminon Parkins' claim for damages for personal injuries arising out of a motor vehicle accident and for such ancillary or other relief as may be proper.
