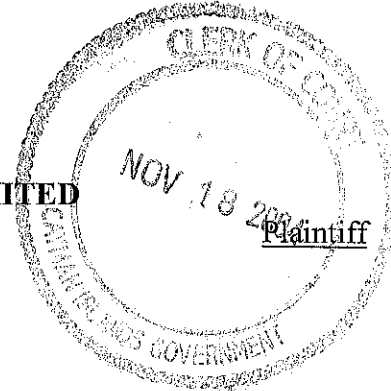

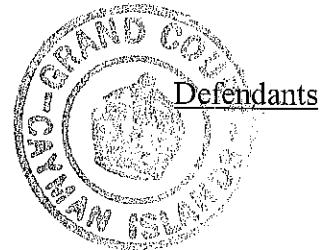


ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE ALL THE PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge of the Grand Court in Chambers at George Town, Grand Cayman at 9.30 o'clock on the 19th day of January 2004 on the hearing of an application pursuant to Section 48 and/or 63 of the Trusts Law (2001 Revision) and for the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court by the Plaintiff as Trustee of the Trust known as The Circle Trust dated 8th December 2000 by which the Plaintiff seeks in the events which have happened the following orders and directions until further order of this Honourable Court:

- (1) that directions may be given as whether or not the Deed dated 13 October 2004 validly and effectively removed the Plaintiff as a trustee of the Trust;
- (2) that directions may be given as whether or note the Deed dated 13 October 2004 validly and effectively appointed the Fourth Defendant as a trustee of the Trust;

- (3) subject to and pending a further order herein:
- (i) that the Plaintiff be authorised and directed to administer the said Trust in accordance with its terms and to reimburse itself from time to time and to pay all costs and expenses incurred by it as trustee out of the assets of the Trust;
 - (ii) that the Plaintiff be authorised to cause directors of companies directly or indirectly owned by the trustee of the Trust to make provision for payment to the Plaintiff of such sums as the Plaintiff shall from time to time consider necessary to meet such costs expenses and reimbursements;
 - (iii) that the Plaintiff be authorised at the expense of the Trust to retain attorneys in these proceedings;
- (4) that directions may be given as to what if any and in what circumstances distributions may be made by the Plaintiff in accordance with the terms of the Trust;
- (5) that directions may be given as to what if any further investigations should be made by the Plaintiffs into the assets of companies which form the assets of the trust, directly or indirectly;
- (6) that directions may be given as to what if any steps the Plaintiff should take to enquire into or intervene in the management of any such companies;
- (7) that provision be made for the costs of this application;
- (8) that all further and necessary order and directions may be given.
