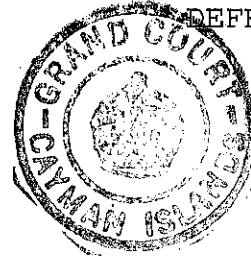
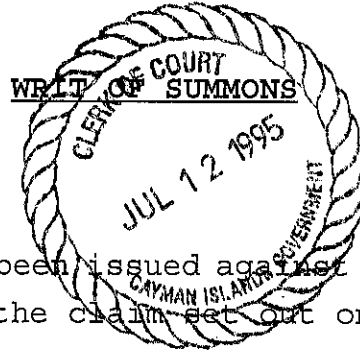

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 28 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this *12th* day of *July* 1995.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

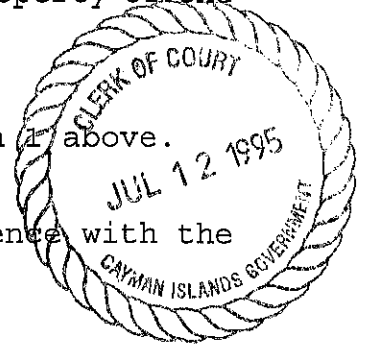
IMPORTANT

INDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff's claim is for:

1. A Declaration that certain books, records, documents, filing cabinets (and their contents), office furniture and sample cabinets in the Defendant's possession are the property of the Plaintiff.
2. The return of the items referred to in paragraph 1 above.
3. Damages for conversion and/or wrongful interference with the items referred to paragraph 1 above.
4. A Declaration that the Defendant has been guilty of misfeasance and breach of trust in relation to the Plaintiff by removing the sum of \$61,245.00 from the Plaintiff's bank account at the Bank of Butterfield (Cayman) Ltd.
5. An Order that the Defendant do repay the Plaintiff the said sum of US\$61,245.00 together with interest from the 6th July 1995 to the date of payment.
6. Damages in respect of the aforesaid misfeasance and breach of trust.
7. Interest on the aforesaid damages pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision).
8. Costs.
