EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before a judge of the Grand Court in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands on 26 January 2005 at am/pm on the hearing *ex parte* of an application by the Plaintiff for the following relief:

1. A Declaration that the purported termination by the Defendant on or about 17 January 2005 of the Plaintiff's contract of employment therewith was unlawful;
2. A Declaration that the Plaintiff is entitled to reasonable notice of termination of her employment in all the circumstances amounting to not less than 12 months or such shorter period that the Court may deem appropriate;
3. A Declaration that in lieu of reasonable notice aforesaid the Plaintiff is entitled to damages at her basic salary amount plus a figure commensurate with her likely commission earnings (based on historical information with an

appropriate adjustment for trend of business to be determined) together with her reasonable costs and disbursements.

4. A Declaration and Order that the Defendant shall pay the Plaintiff's said damages, costs and disbursements;
5. An injunction restraining the Defendant whether by themselves or by their servants or agents or howsoever otherwise from disclosing to any third party any information pertaining to the Defendant's unlawful termination of the Plaintiff's employment on or about 17 January 2005 pending trial or further Order of this Court;
6. An injunction restraining the Defendant whether by their servants, agents or howsoever otherwise from preventing or conspiring to prevent the Plaintiff from gaining lawful employment with an employer of the Plaintiff's choosing whether within the Cayman Islands or elsewhere;
7. That the Plaintiff do have the costs of this application to be taxed on a full indemnity basis if not agreed;
8. Further or other relief.
