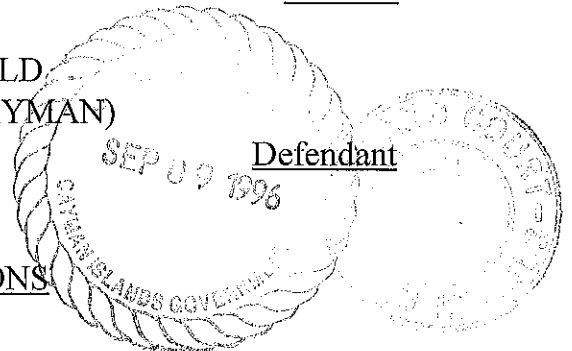

TO: Bank of Butterfield International (Cayman) Limited, of Butterfield House, PO Box 705, Fort Street, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands.

LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this Summons on it, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court Office, The Law Courts, PO Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

BY THIS SUMMONS, which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, Isabelle Al-Ibraheem (née Djeddah), whose address is 302, Residence Claridge, 74, Avenue des Champs Elysées, Paris, France, the Plaintiff claims against the Defendant an order for general administration of The Corduroy Trust ("the Trust") under the direction of this Court, suspended except so far as should be necessary:-

- (1) for the pursuit of an inquiry as to whether the Second Amendment to the Trust, dated the 19th day of July 1996, is a valid and effectual exercise of the Settlor's power of amendment; and
- (2) for the pursuit of an inquiry as to the propriety of past releases of capital from the Trust by the Defendant.

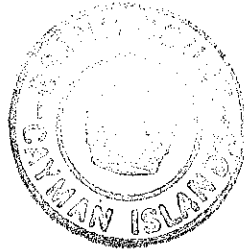
AND an order for such further or other relief as the Court thinks fit, including all necessary accounts, inquiries and directions;

AND that provision be made for the costs of this application.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against it as the Court may think just and expedient.
