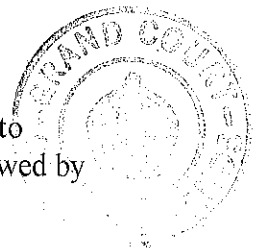

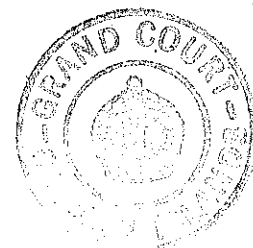

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is the Administratrix of the Estate of Lorraine Stacey Russell, deceased, late of George Town, Grand Cayman, who died intestate on the 7th day of July 1995, and on the 27th day of March 1996 Letters of Administration of the said estate were duly granted to the Plaintiff as such administrator by the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands.
2. That at the time of his death the said deceased was at all material times the owner of and entitled to the possession of one gold ring; one gold chain and pendant and one walker.
3. The Defendant is and has been since some date prior to the 14th day of July 1995 wrongfully in possession of the said items.
4. By letter dated the 30th day of April 1996 the Plaintiff, through her Attorney-at-Law, demanded the said items of the Defendant, but the Defendant has wrongfully failed and refused to deliver up the said items to the Plaintiff and has thereby converted the same to her own use and wrongfully deprived the Estate of the said deceased thereof by reason whereof the said Estate has suffered loss and damage.

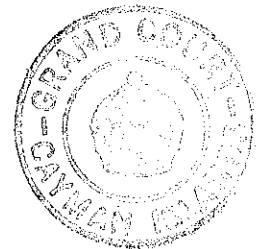
