EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 27th day of March 2005, at 9³⁰ o'clock in the fore/after noon, on the hearing of an ex parte application by the Attorney General for the following orders:-

1. That leave be granted for the enforcement of the Convention award for the recovery of USD\$25,934.72 and 6,407.10 litas from Beverage World Corporation dated 15 December 2003 which is exhibited as "LC1" to the affidavit of Lindsey Cacho sworn herein on the 16th day of March 2005.
2. That the Order made herein and a copy of the affidavit of Lindsey Cacho dated the 16th day of March 2005 be served upon the debtor, Beverage World Corporation at its registered office.

3. That within fourteen days after service of the Order herein the said debtor may apply to set aside the Order and the award shall not be enforced until after expiration of that period or if the debtor applies within the fourteen day period to set aside the Order, until after the application is finally disposed of.
4. Such other Orders and Directions as this Honourable Court may deem fit.
