

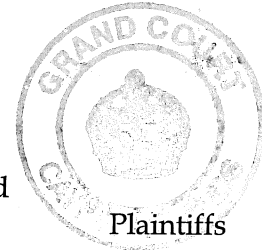

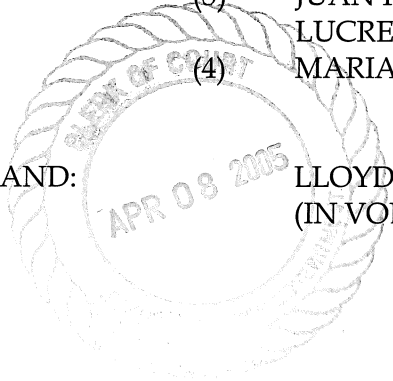

1. An Order, pursuant to Section 10 of the Trusts Law (2001 Revision), that Butterfield Bank (Cayman) Limited, or some other fit and proper person, be appointed sole trustee of the above-mentioned Settlement upon such terms as the Court thinks fit;
2. Any necessary vesting order;
3. Further or other relief;
4. That provision may be made for the costs of this application.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to it as the Court may think just and expedient.
