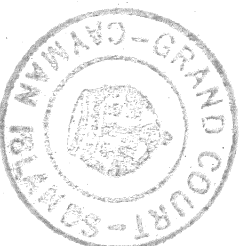

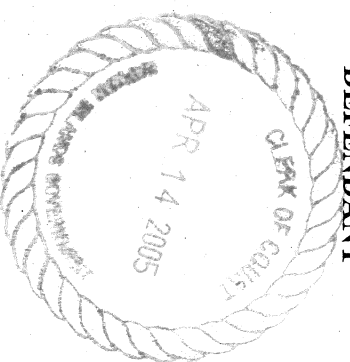

ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET THE DEFENDANT attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of , 2005 at o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff that:

1. The custody, care and control and guardianship of **JADE DAYSHIA CHANTAI SCOTT**, a minor be committed to the Plaintiff
2. The Plaintiff have the right to reside outside the Cayman Islands with the said **JADE DAYSHIA CHANTAI SCOTT**.
3. The Defendant be granted access.
4. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just.

The Plaintiff is the father of the minor.

The Defendant is the mother of the minor.

The date of birth of the minor is June 12th 1997.

The minor is presently in the custody of the Plaintiff with the consent of the Defendant.
The Defendant has signed an agreement consenting to the relief sought.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons upon her counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service form to the Courts Office at P.O. Box 495 GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes:

1. This Summons may not be served later than four (4) calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the above date unless renewed by order of the Court.

2. IF THE DEFENDANT DOES NOT ATTEND PERSONALLY OR BY HIS ATTORNEY AT THE TIME AND PLACE ABOVE-MENTIONED, SUCH ORDER WILL BE MADE AS THIS HONOURABLE COURT MAY THINK JUST AND EXPEDIENT.

THIS ORIGINATING SUMMONS is filed by the Plaintiff herein whose address for service is 47 Boreal Way, West Bay, Grand Cayman.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands,

he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
