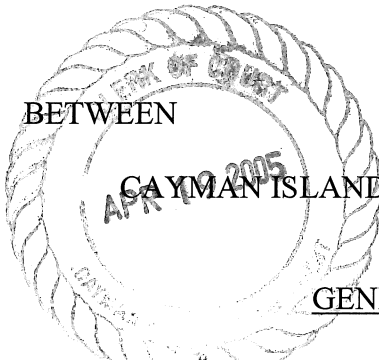

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

IMPORTANT

Directions for Acknowledgment of Service are given with the accompanying form.

- (i) The Plaintiff who was a News Reporter for the Defendant as of 1 August 2000 claims damages for breach of contract, personal injuries, sustained losses and expenses incurred (together with interest thereon pursuant to The Judicature Law (1995 Revision)) as a result of personal injuries suffered by her as a result of a stress related illness caused by a breach by the employer of her working conditions which included making her perform excessive hours and work load which triggered the activation of injuries which manifested themselves on or about 30 April 2002. On 30 April 2003 the Plaintiff had a butterfly lupus type rash over her face and following a test was diagnosed as having a positive ds DNA activity and thus suffering from Systemic Lupus Erythematosus (SLE) activity. On 18 May 2001 there was no evidence of any activity of SLE. The active SLE and symptoms were caused as a result of the negligent treatment of the Plaintiff brought about by the Defendant exposing her to an unreasonable risk of injury due to its failure to ensure so far as reasonably practicable her health, safety and welfare at work.
