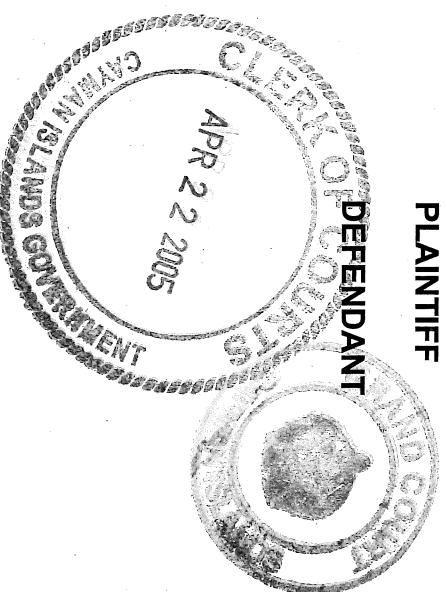

LET THE DEFENDANT, within 14 days after service of this Summons on him, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office, P.O. Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application by the Plaintiff of 96 Sandalwood Crescent No. 9, George Town, Grand Cayman against the Defendant of 5314 Hiialeah, Houston, Texas 77092, USA seeks the determination of the Court as follows:-

THE PLAINTIFF seeks an Order as follows:-

1. **THAT** the Order made on the 30th day of May 2002 in the District Court 310 Judicial District Harris County, Texas be mirrored into the Grand Court of the Cayman Islands.
2. **THAT** the Final Decree of Divorce between Irene Cox and Alfred B. Cox be recognised by the Cayman Islands Court;
3. **THAT** the Order in respect of the minor child, ALEC BRUCE COX be recognised by the Cayman Islands Court in the form of the Order made by the 310th Judicial District Court of Harris County, Texas, USA;
4. **THAT** the Order in respect of the minor child, ALEC BRUCE COX be establish that the primary residence of the minor child is that of the Cayman Islands in accordance with the Order made by the 310th Judicial District Court of Harris County Texas, USA be so recognised by the Cayman Island Court;
5. **THAT** service of this Summons be dispensed by this Honourable Court;

6. **THAT** any other relief this Honourable Court deems fit;
7. **THAT** the cost of this Application be awarded to the Plaintiff.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.
