

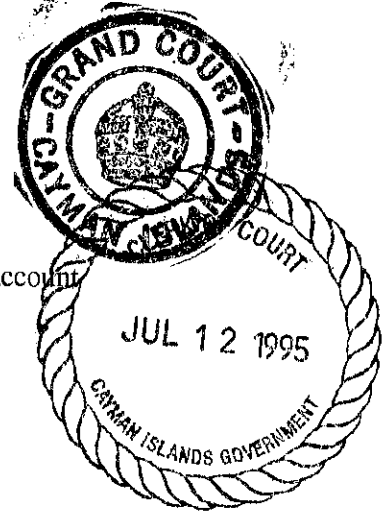

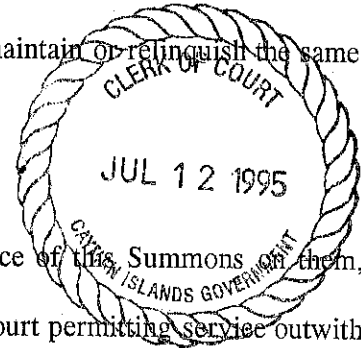

AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service (or within time stated in the Order of this Court permitting service outwith the jurisdiction in respect of those defendants residing overseas) return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman.

By this Summons which is issued on the application of the Plaintiff, the Plaintiff seeks court directions for the determination of this action.

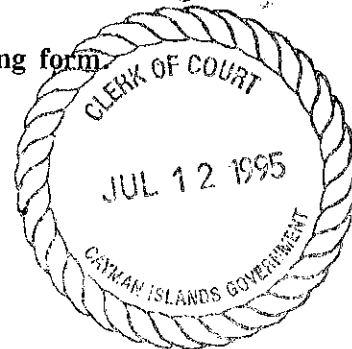
If a Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgement may be given or Order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

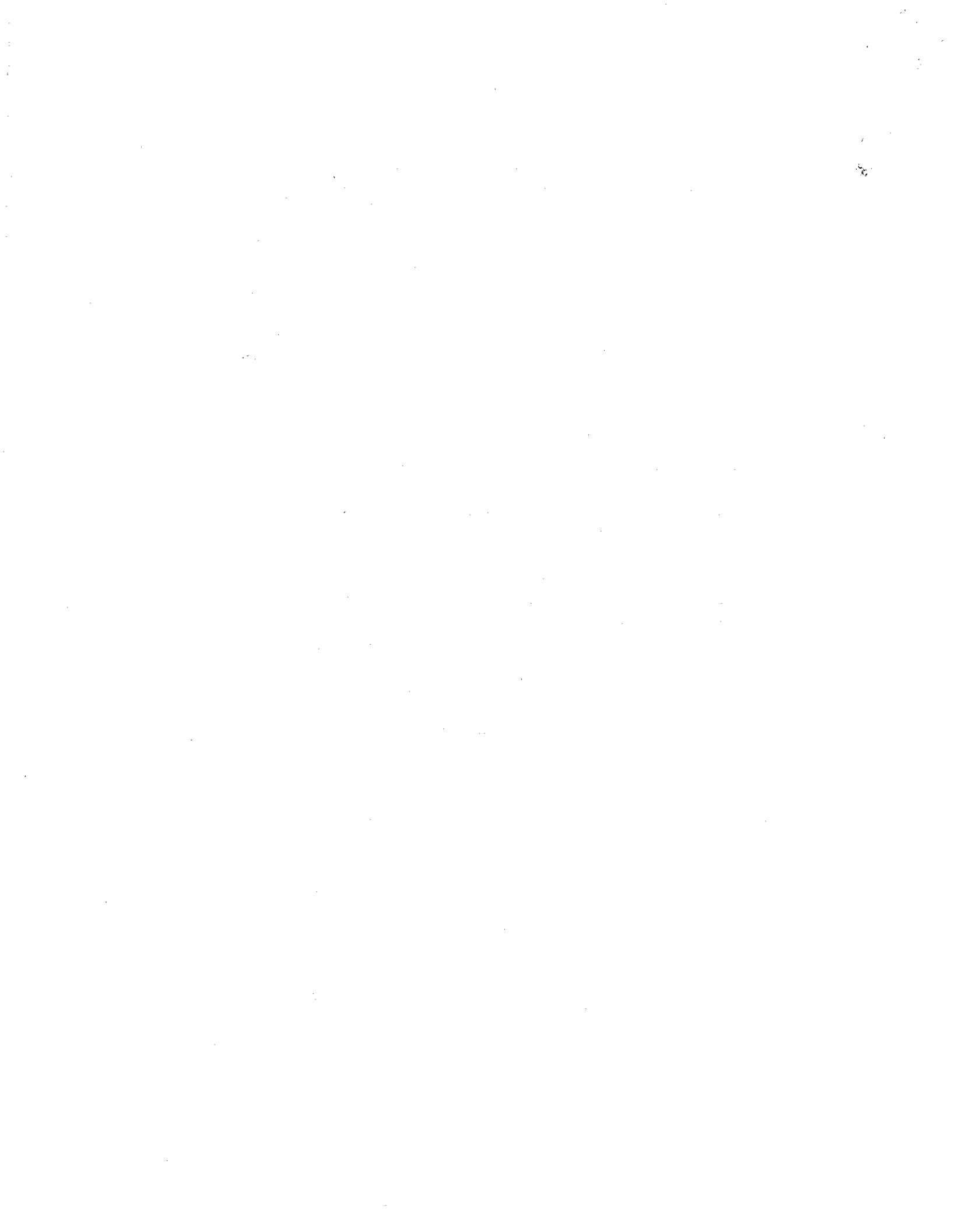

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of *Acknowledgment of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
3. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (*the named stated on the Originating Summons*)".
4. Where the Defendant is a **FIRM** and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a **PARTNER** by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
5. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual **TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN**, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is a **LIMITED COMPANY** the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorized to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
7. Where the Defendant is a **MINOR** or a **MENTAL PATIENT**, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian *ad litem*.
8. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited

company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
