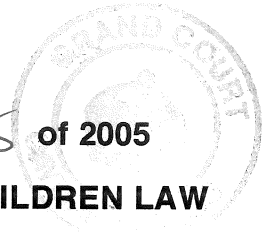

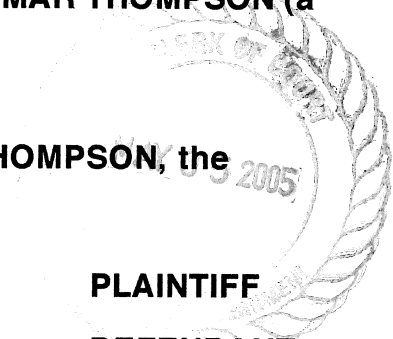

1 That he be granted Guardianship, custody, care and control of the two minor children, AMY THOMPSON, who was born on 28th December, 1995 and is therefore 9 years old; and SHEMAR THOMPSON who was born on 7th February, 1999 and is therefore 6 years old, with the Defendant having reasonable access to them.

2 That the Defendant do pay maintenance for the two children in such sum as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.

3 Further and in the alternative, that the Plaintiff be granted defined access to the said children.

4 Such further and/or other relief as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after the service of this summons on her counting the day of service return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Courts Office.
