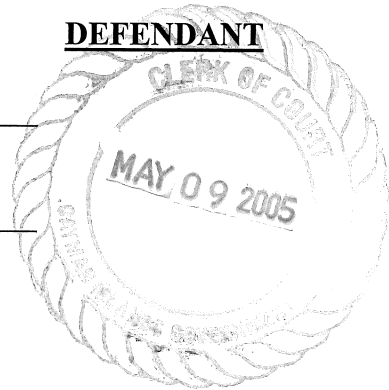

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service, stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

THE PLAINTIFFS' CLAIM is for:

1. An injunction to restrain the Defendant whether by its servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from causing, allowing, procuring or permitting the construction or erection of an above-the-ground gasoline and diesel fuel pipe-line on land situate at Block 109B Parcel 91 in the Cayman Brac Registration Section thereby causing a nuisance or negligent injury loss and damage to the Plaintiffs and to the Plaintiffs' adjoining property situate at Block 109B, Parcel 92 in the said registration Section

2. An injunction to restrain the Defendant whether by its servants or agents or otherwise howsoever from causing, allowing, procuring or permitting the construction or erection of an above-the-ground gasoline and diesel fuel pipe-line on land situate at Block 109B Parcel 91 in the Cayman Brac Registration Section without having obtained the necessary consent to such development of land as required by the Development and Planning Law (2003 Revision);

3. Damages for nuisance, negligence and breach of statutory duty;

4. Interest thereon pursuant to s.34 of the Judicature Law (2004 Revision) on such sums and at such rate as the Court shall think fit;

5. Costs.
