

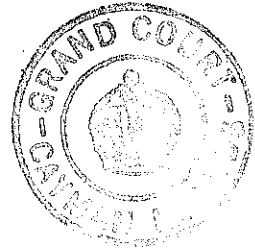

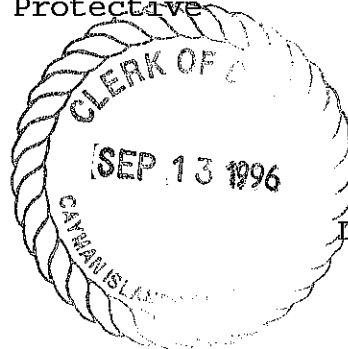

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

1. THAT after payment and discharge of all debts and liabilities, including the costs of winding up all monies found standing to the credit of Surgical Protective Insurance Company Ltd. be paid out forthwith to:
 - (i) Ethel Audet (holder of \$40,000.00 ordinary shares);
 - (ii) Carol Moore (holder of \$40,000.00 ordinary shares); and
 - (iii) Nydia Mayola Quiroga, M.D. (holder of \$40,000.00

ordinary shares);
in rateable proportion to their shareholdings;

2. THAT Notice of paragraphs 1 above be gazetted and sent to the Registrar of Companies and to the Financial Services Department forthwith;
3. THAT costs be in the cause.

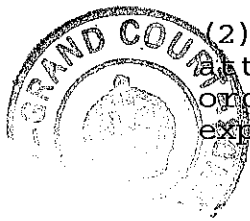
AND LET THE DEFENDANTS within (14 days) after service of this summons counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Courts office.
