By this Summons, issued on the application of CHRISTOPHER MAURICE SEYMOUR of Gorning Avenue, George Town Grand Cayman, the Plaintiff claim against the Defendant for guardianship, custody, care and control of their minor child JAVON CHRISTOPHER SEYMOUR under section 7 (1) of the Guardianship and Custody of Children Law (revised).

1. That the Plaintiff be given sole guardianship, custody, care and control of the minor child
2. That the Defendant be given liberal access to the child on weekends and at such other times as may be agreed by the Parties, in the absence of such the Court shall define such access
3. That the minor child continue his primary school education at Glowell Preparatory School in Jamaica, until such time as the Plaintiff deem fit
4. That while attending primary school in Jamaica the minor child will be in the temporary care and control of Mrs. Sandra Strachan.
5. Such further or other relief as this Honourable Court deems just.

If the Defendant does not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to him as the Court may think just and expedient.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an acknowledgement of service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgement of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledgement of service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed , the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name , with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is used as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
