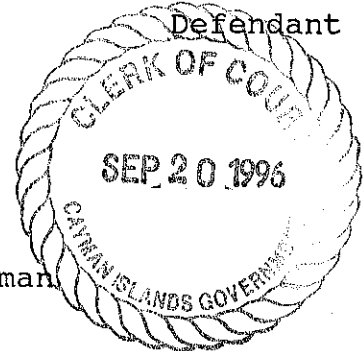
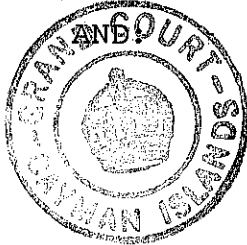

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the Statement of Claim.

Within 14 days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

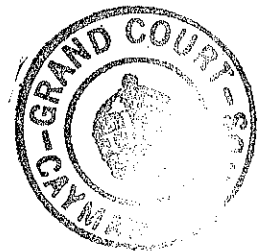
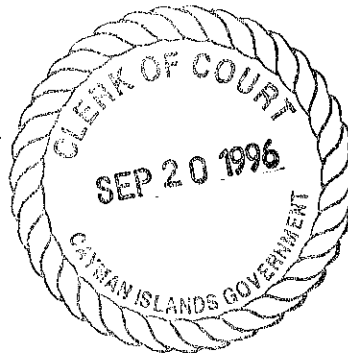
INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM

The Plaintiff claims damages for the Defendant's breach of an undated Tenancy Agreement and Operation Management Schedule made between the Plaintiff and the Defendant whereby the Defendant agreed to rent a petrol filling station and store situate at West Bay Road, Grand Cayman to the Plaintiff on a yearly tenancy commencing on the 1st November 1988 and for the Defendant's breach of the terms of a contemporaneous assignment of the goodwill of the said station and store, together with interest upon damages pursuant to the Judicature Law 1995.
